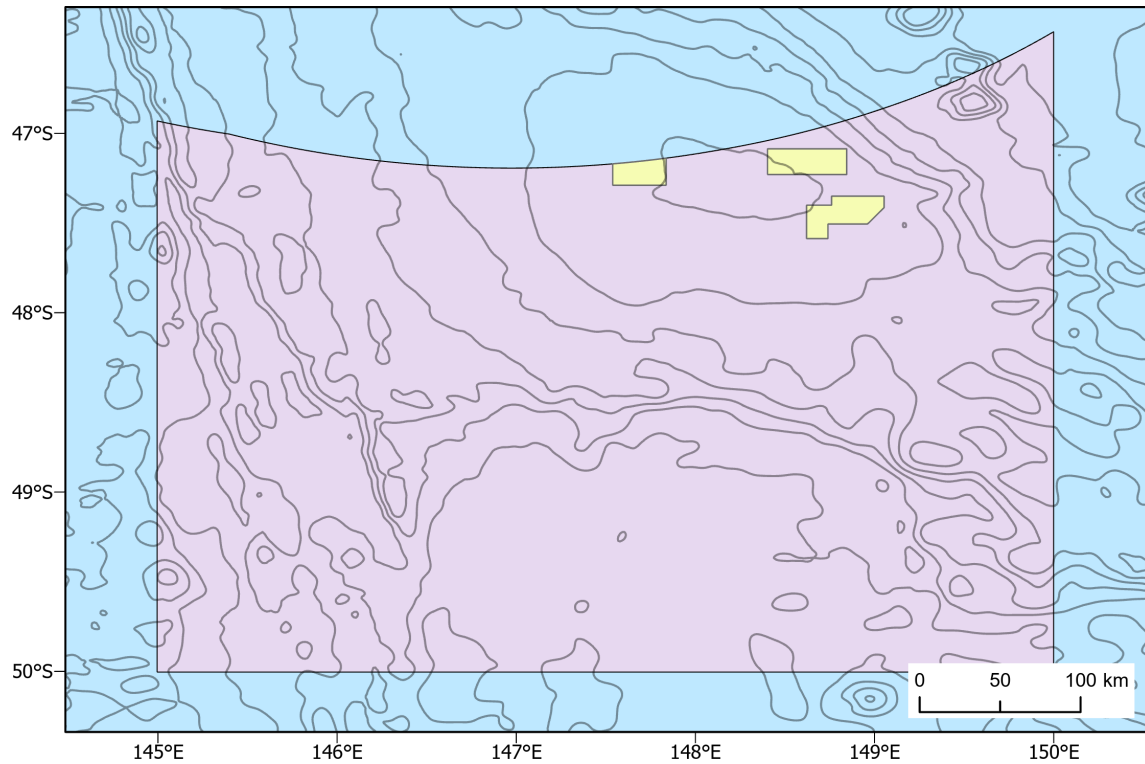

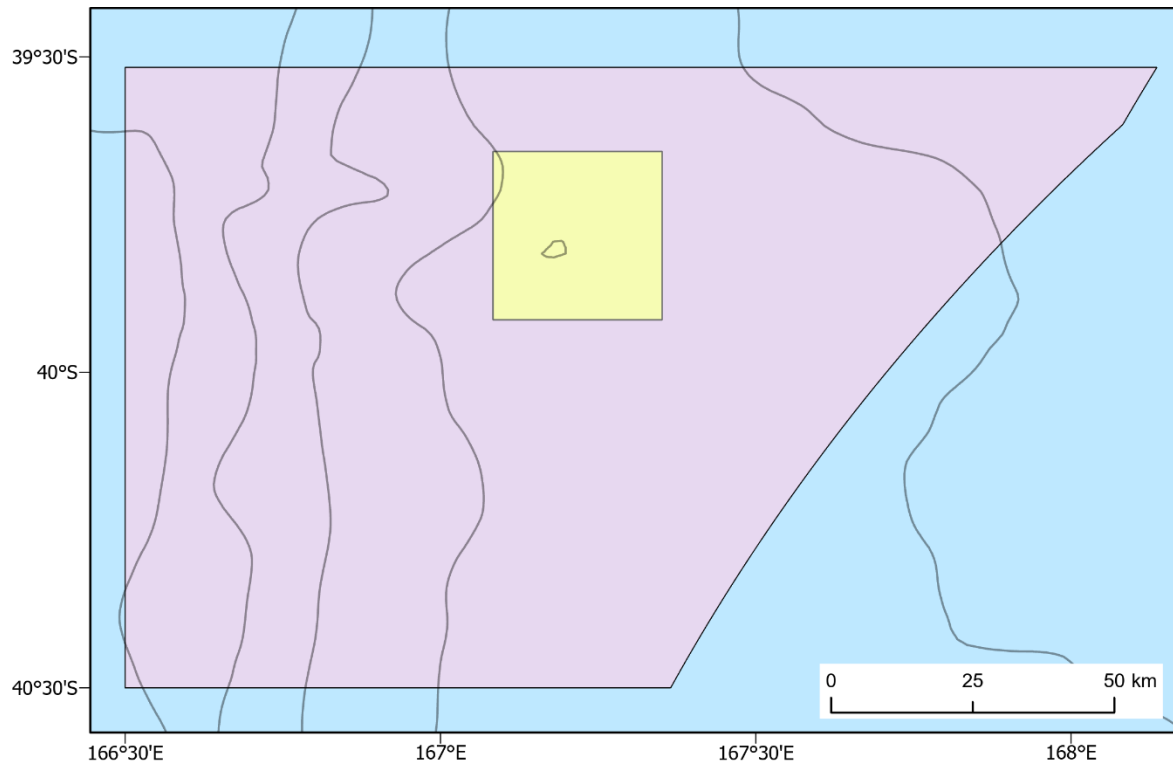

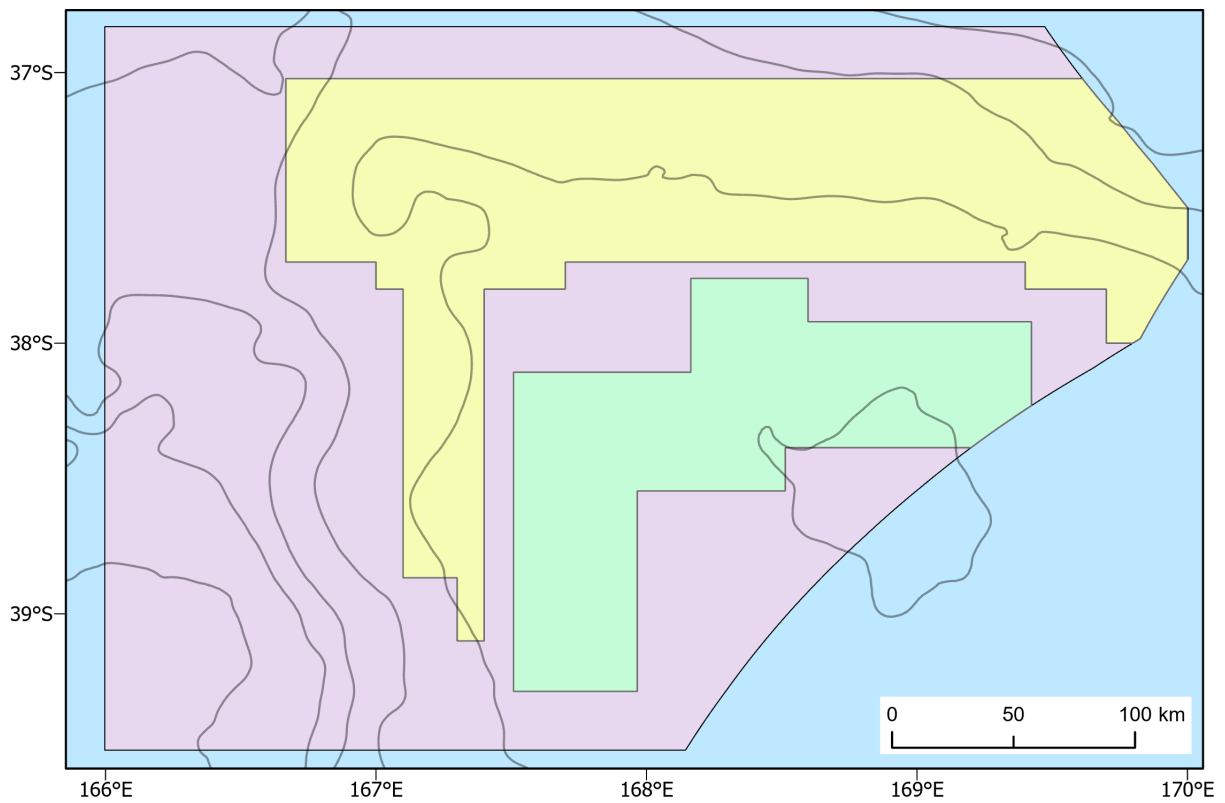

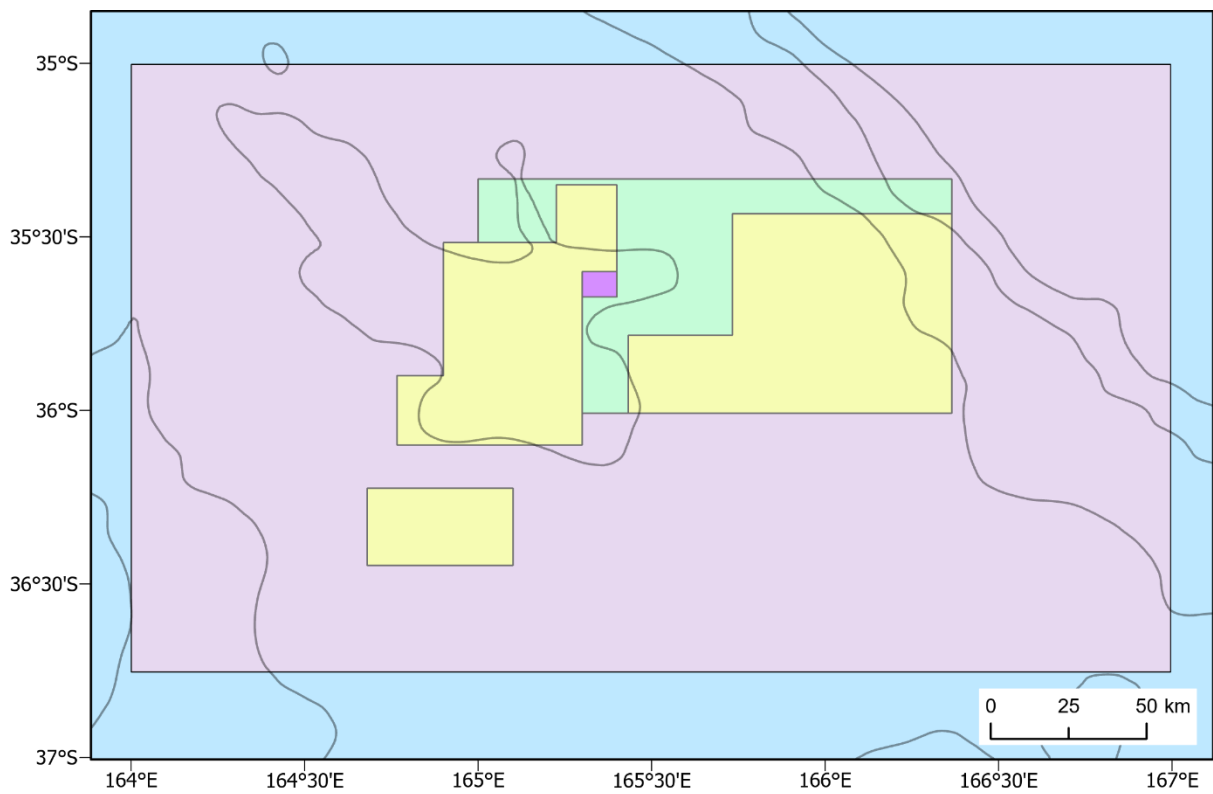
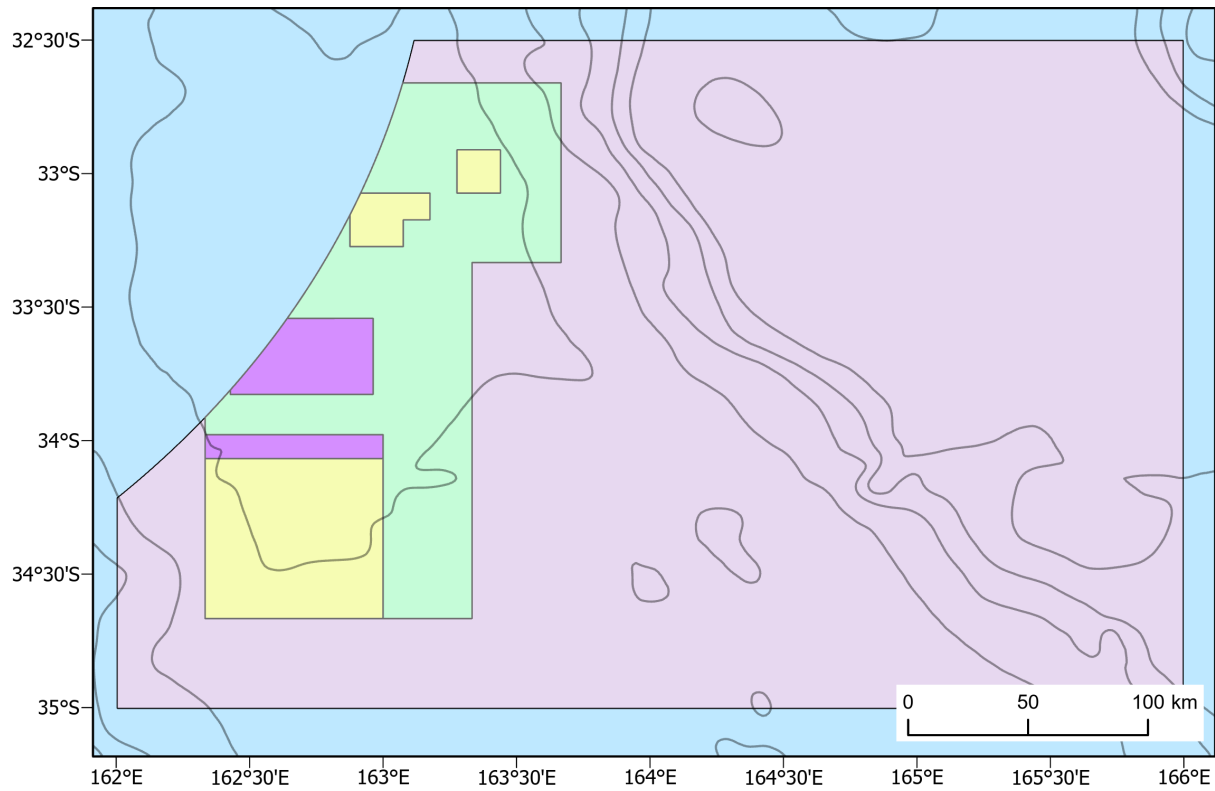

 24 long lining.

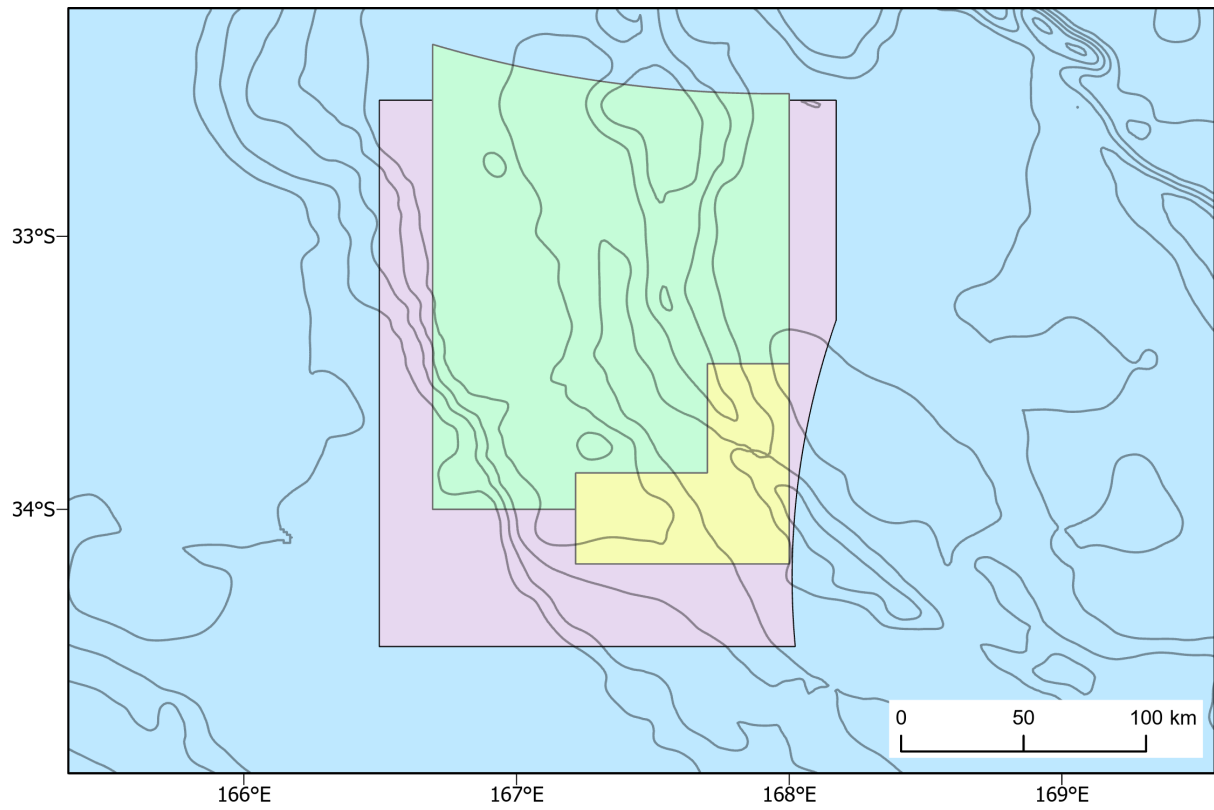

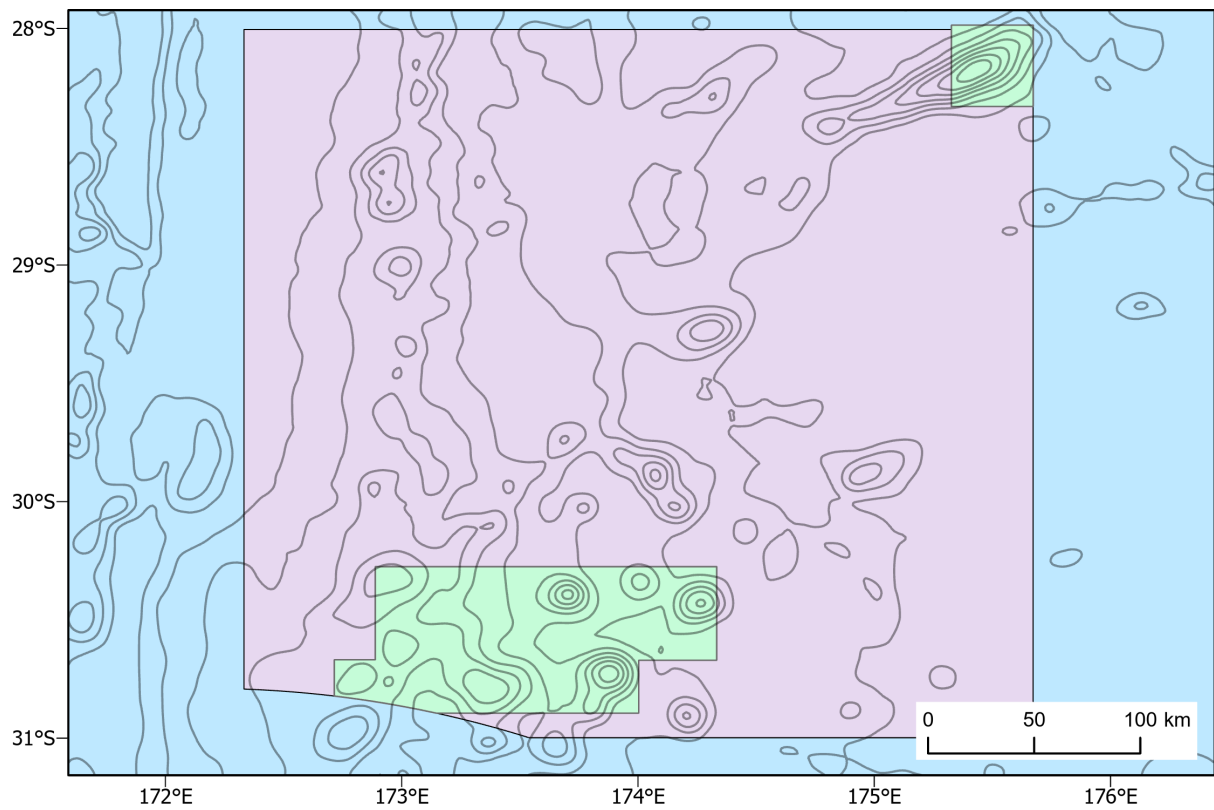


Figure S7. Three Kings Fishery Management Area (pink salmon). Bottom Line Management Areas (green) allow bottom long lining.

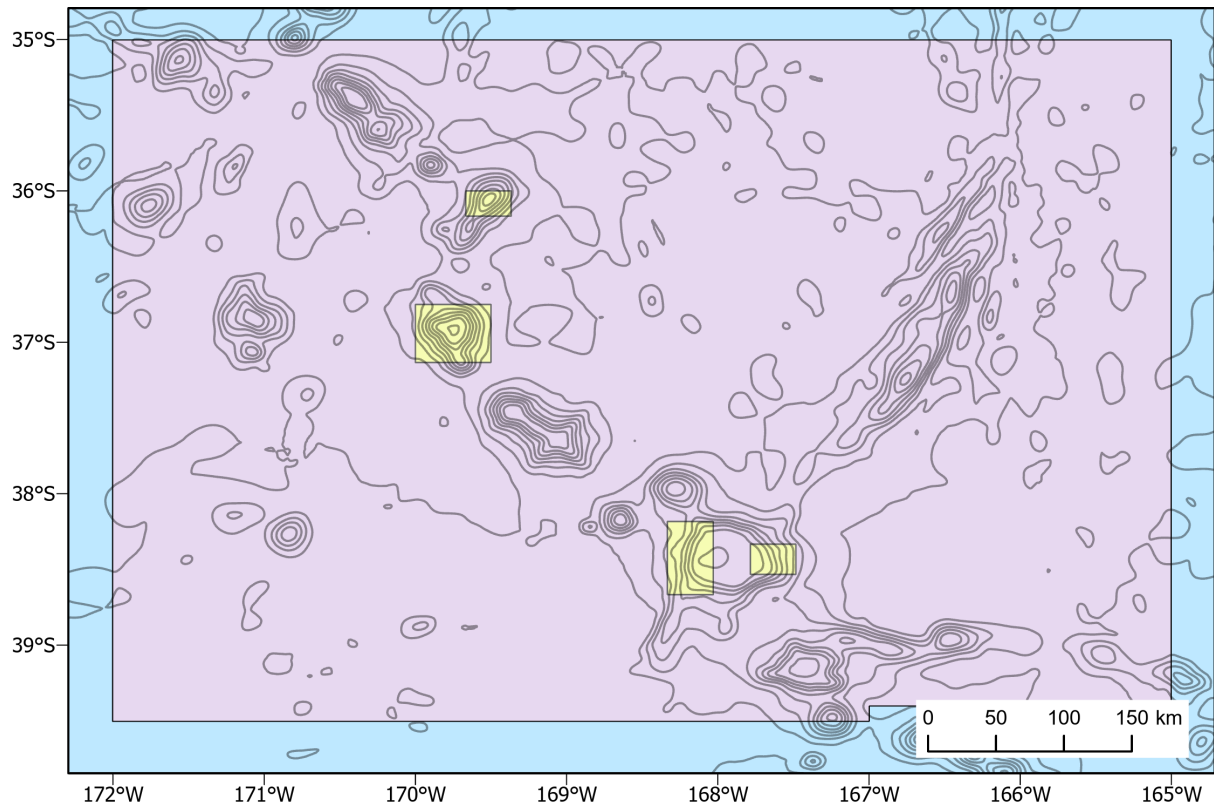

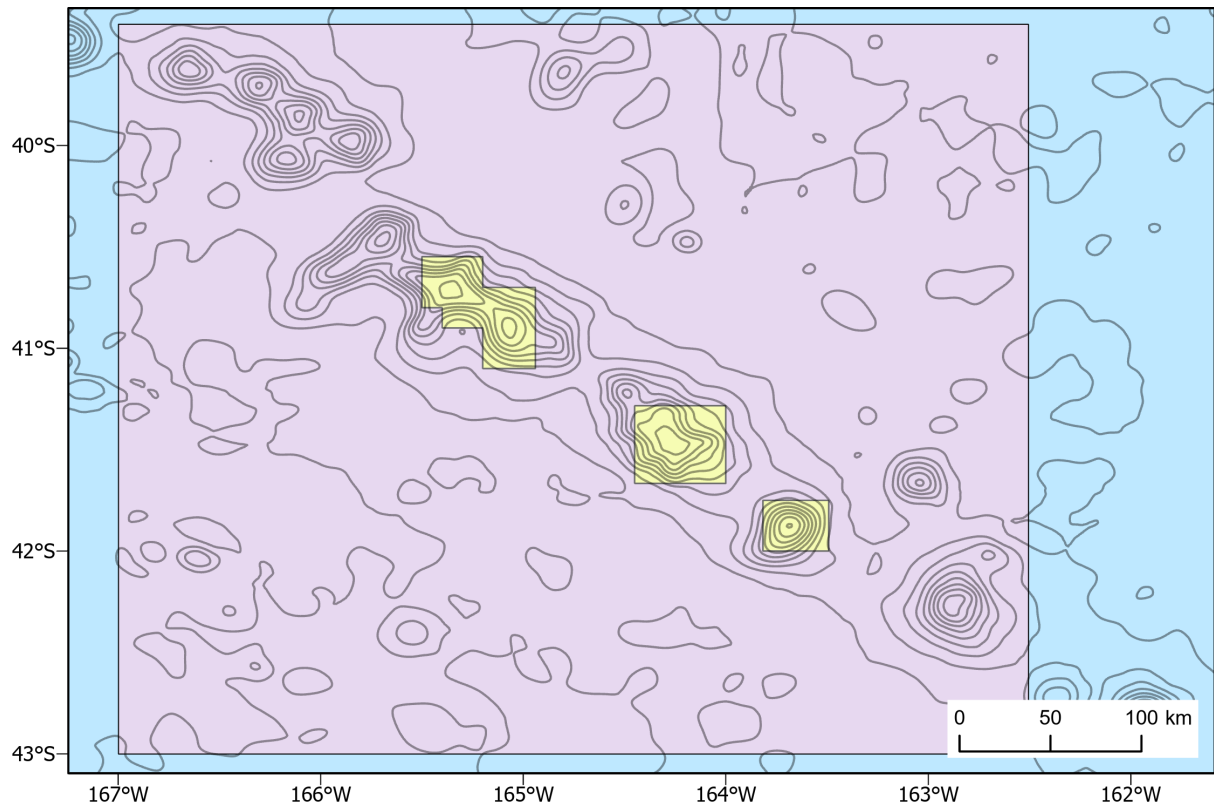

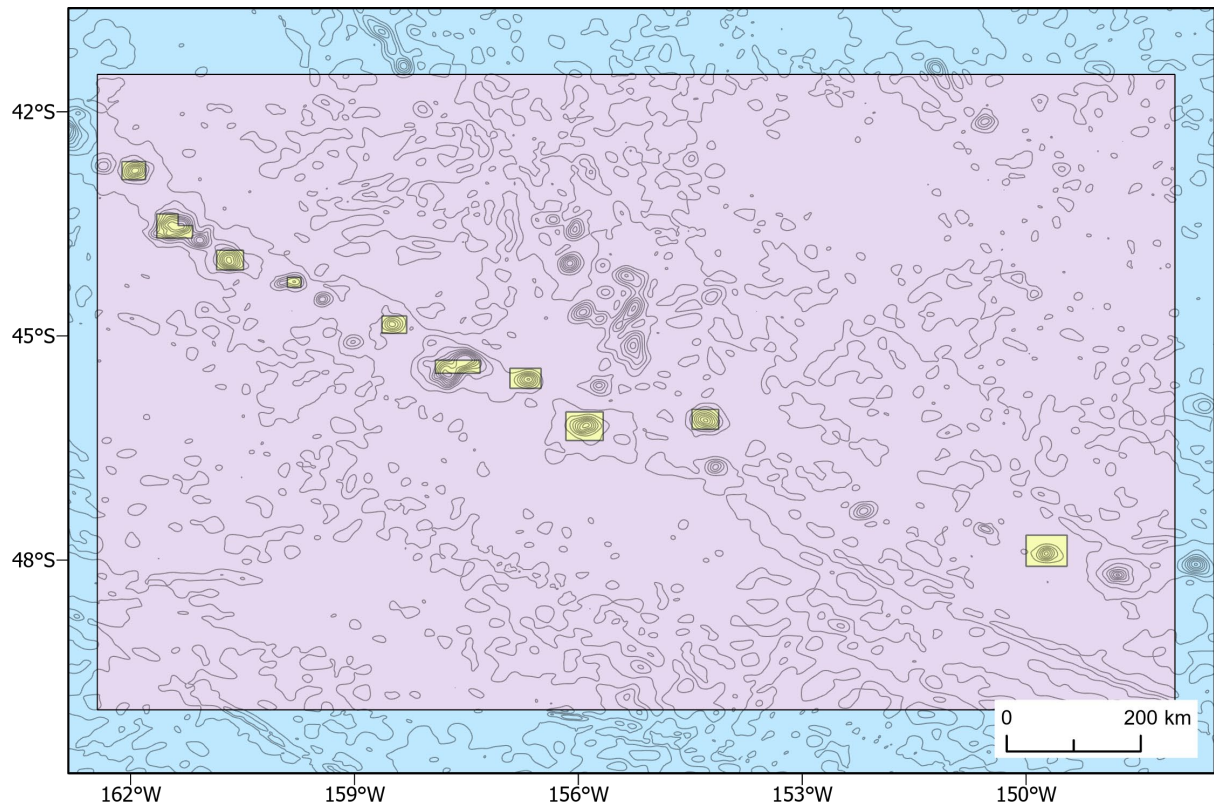

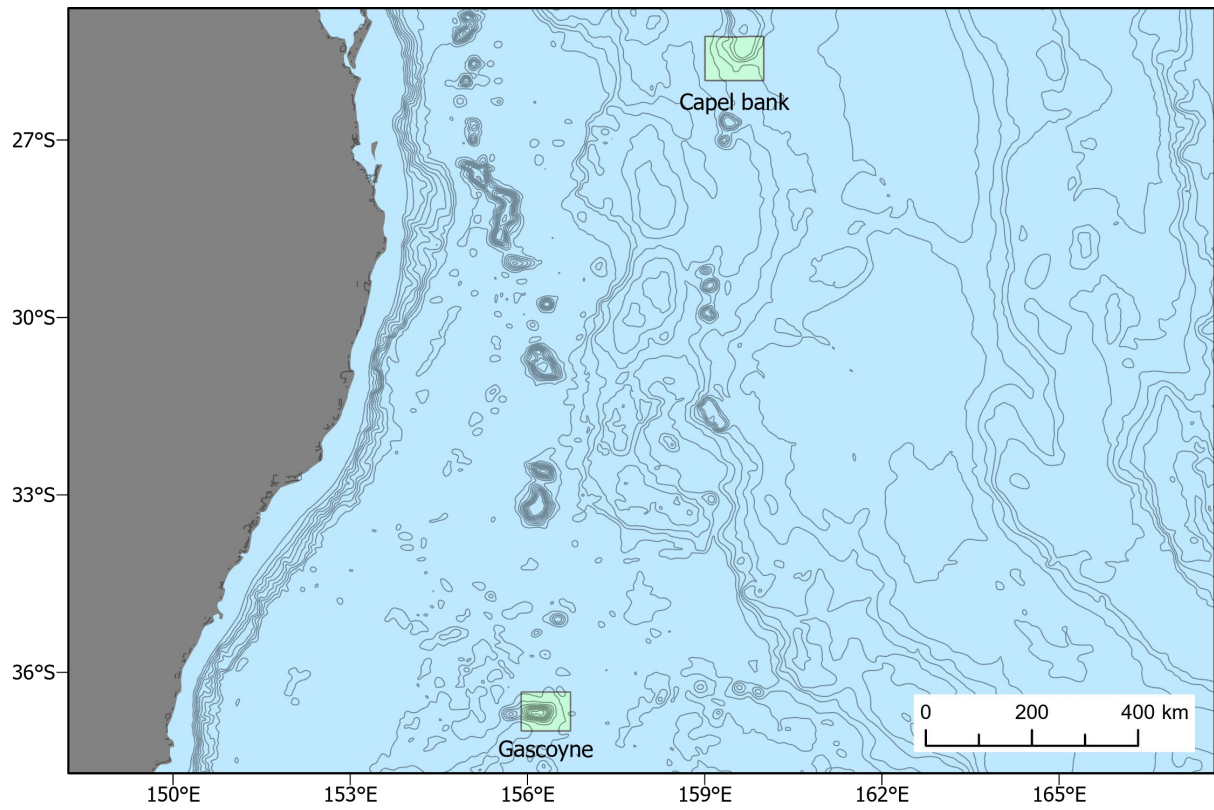


Figure S11. Capel Bank and Gascoyne Bottom Line Management Areas (green). Bottom Line Management Areas allow bottom long lining.
